

**IMMUNOGEN:** Recombinant human full length wild type p53 protein.

**DESCRIPTION:** p53 is a tumor suppressor gene expressed in a wide variety of tissue types and is involved in

regulating cell growth, replication, and apoptosis. It binds to mdm2, SV40 T antigen and human papilloma virus E6 protein. p53 senses DNA damage and possibly facilitates repair. Mutation involving p53 is found in a wide variety of malignant tumors, including breast, ovarian, bladder,

colon, lung, and melanoma.

APPLICATIONS: Immunohistochemistry (IHC)

IHC PROCEDURE: Specimen Preparation: Formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded tissues are suitable for use with this

primary antibody.

**Deparaffinization:** Deparaffinize slides using xylene or xylene alternative and graded alcohols. **Antibody Dilution:** If using the concentrate format of this product, dilute the antibody 1:100. The dilutions are estimates; actual results may differ because of variability in methods and protocols. **Antigen Retrieval:** Boil tissue section in 10mM citrate buffer, pH 6.0 for 10 min followed by

cooling at RT for 20 min.

Primary Antibody Incubation: Incubate for 30 minutes at RT.

**Slide Washing:** Slides must be washed in between steps. Rinse slides with PBS/0.05% Tween. **Visualization:** Detect the antibody as instructed by the instructions provided with the visualization

system.
